

Preferred Lab Benefit

Information for State Employee Health Plan members

The University of Kansas Health System has negotiated rates for laboratory work for the State Employee Health Plan (SEHP).

All covered SEHP members can have blood drawn at any one of the conveniently located health system outpatient walk-in laboratories. All covered SEHP members who use health system providers can also have specimens collected at their provider's office.

For Plan A

The University of Kansas Health System lab will draw specimens and process the lab work at the negotiated rates. Your health plan will pay the claim at 100% (no deductibles, copayments or coinsurance for covered lab services).

Test results will be transmitted to your ordering provider in a timely manner. If you are a current health system patient, test results will be available in MyChart.

For Plans C, J and N

The University of Kansas Health System lab will draw specimens and process the lab work at negotiated rates. Your health plan provider will notify you of the amount you owe until your

deductible is met. The amount will reflect the negotiated rate. Your office visit or other services may also be applied to your deductible until that deductible is met. Once you have met your deductible, all covered lab services are paid at 100% of the allowable charge.
